
PRINCIPAL'S WEEKLY UPDATE AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION

With Lent now behind us, we enter the **Easter season** with hearts renewed by the promise of hope, joy, and new life. This week at school, our focus has shifted from the quiet reflection of Lent to the celebration of the Resurrection. Students have been learning about the Road to Emmaus—the powerful story of two disciples who, while walking and grieving, are joined by the risen Jesus. Though they do not recognize Him at first, their hearts are stirred by His words, and they finally recognize Him

in the breaking of the bread. This story reminds us that Jesus walks with us in our everyday lives, often when we least expect it.

Alongside our Easter celebrations, we have also taken time each morning to honour the life of **Pope Francis**, whose recent passing has deeply touched the global Church. 


Help Needed: Prop Transport to the WAG

IMPORTANT REMINDER ABOUT SCHOOL ENTRY PROCEDURES



At St. Charles, our top priority is the safety and well-being of our students and staff. To help us maintain a secure and calm environment, we kindly ask all parents and visitors to follow these important guidelines:

- All visitors must enter through the main front doors.
- Please check in at the front office—even if you're just dropping something off or need to grab something from your child's cubby or locker.
- Parents should not be going upstairs, down the classroom hallways, or into the kindergarten area for drop-off, pick-up, or to help their child with something. These areas are for students and staff only during school hours.
- All student drop-offs and pick-ups must be done outside. Parents waiting in the hallways is disruptive and causes confusion for both reception and staff.

We recognize that most parents are doing their best to follow these expectations, and we sincerely thank you. However, there have been ongoing challenges with some individuals entering areas of the school without checking in or using alternate entry points. Even if the intentions are good, this puts added pressure on our staff and compromises the careful safety procedures we have in place. We are asking for your support and cooperation to help reinforce these expectations. It takes a collective effort to keep our school safe, respectful, and focused on learning. Thank you for helping us protect the integrity of our learning environment and maintain the safety and security of our community.
