ONLINE SAFETY REMINDER FOR FAMILIES



The **Winnipeg Police Service** has recently shared an important advisory highlighting growing concerns about online safety for children and youth. They note that individuals are increasingly targeting young people through popular platforms such as gaming apps and social media, especially those who may be feeling vulnerable.

Families are encouraged to stay engaged with their children's online activity and watch for signs such as sudden changes in behaviour, secrecy around devices, or exposure to concerning content.

We recommend having open conversations with your children about online safety and ensuring they know to speak to a trusted adult if something doesn't feel right. Supporting our students' well-being-both online and offline-continues to be a shared priority.

TERM 3 REPORT CARDS

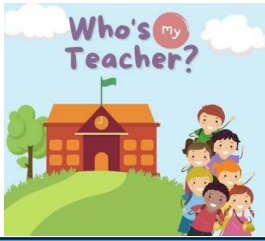


Report cards will **only be distributed on the last day of school**, Tuesday, June 30th. Students will receive their report cards at dismissal time (11:35am).
